Programme Outline

THEME: "Journeying together as peoples of Asia... and they went a different way" (Mt 2:12)

27th Nov 2025

We will begin the programme with an inaugural ceremony at 4:00 p.m., followed by Holy Mass at 5:00 p.m. Each day, one of the main speakers will deliver a keynote address. The theme of the keynote on the 27th will be part of the central theme — "They Went on a Different Way." The day will conclude with a concert by the RexBand.

28th Nov 2025

The second day will begin with morning prayer, followed by the Holy Mass. The day's keynote address will focus on the second part of the central theme, "Journeying Together as Peoples of Asia."

After the keynote address, the delegates will gather in small groups for 'Conversations in the Spirit.' Conversations in the Spirit is a mode of communication that fosters common and shared responsibility by opening up to the Spirit's inspiration and identifying what the Spirit is conveying to the praying community so that decisions can be made accordingly.

At noon, we will witness seven 'Impact Sessions' where participants can choose from diverse Impact Sessions being held simultaneously across seven different venues within the hotel complex.

Following lunch, Stream-specific gatherings will take place in five venues, with the theme 'A Synodal Church in Mission: Walking Together as a Community'. The group will be divided according to their vocations/life situations: Bishops, Priests and Deacons, Religious Sisters, Youth, and Lay Adults.

The Evening Rally will be a powerful time of ministry with the theme 'Encountering Christ' referencing the quote, "I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them..." (EG3). The Rally will include short talks, witness testimonies, worship, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and more.

After dinner, we will have cultural presentations from different countries in Asia.

29th Nov 2025

The third day will begin with morning prayer. The day's keynote address will focus on the theme "Living and Sharing the Story of Jesus – Journeying towards 2033 as Peoples of Asia."

After the keynote address, the delegates will gather in small groups for 'Conversations in the Spirit.'

After the small group gathering, we will have a panel showcasing a few notable initiatives that can be offered for the Church in Asia.



At noon, we will witness seven 'Impact Sessions', where the participants can choose from diverse sessions held simultaneously across seven different venues within the hotel complex.

Post-lunch, Profession-specific gatherings will take place in six venues. The group will be divided according to their professions. Bishops, Priests, and Religious can join any group they like.

After Coffee, we will visit the Minor Basilica of St. Anne for an open event. We will start with the Holy Mass, followed by dinner and an Evening Rally open to all.

The Evening Rally will be a powerful time of ministry, featuring a short talk, worship, concerts, and more.

30th Nov 2025

The fourth day will begin with morning prayer. The day's keynote address will focus on the theme 'Go Forth' (Mathew 28:18-20).

With this session, we will proceed to the concluding part of the Congress, which includes the final statement, concluding remarks, followed by the Holy Mass and Commissioning Ceremony.
